
Dear Mr. Rodriguez:

An inspection the property located at 30 Hawleyville Road shows that your on-site activities have violated the Newtown Inland Wetlands Regulations. These activities include, but are not limited to, depositing material into wetland areas, clearing wetlands, and causing sediment to discharge into wetlands. Selected photos are enclosed for your review.

If you have a wetlands permit for these activities, you must produce it immediately. If suitable documentation is not produced, you must complete and file a wetlands permit application with this office, within ten (10) days, for your on-site activities.

Failure to comply with this order will be subject to fines and penalties as the law may provide.


Dear Sirs,

Based on an inspection of the above noted lot, I have observed that you have permitted a disturbance in violation of Newtown Wetland Regulations. I have photo documented the site and have a complete inventory of activities which are occurring on this site.

1. In accordance of section 19 of the Town of Newtown Wetlands Regulations, you are hereby fined the sum of \$1000.00 per these violations. You are ordered to set all E&S controls to the standards which are required by the 2002 CT E&S Guidelines. After the corrections to the E&S have been made, they shall be inspected and approved by this official.
2. You are also ordered to apply, and receive approval for, a wetlands permit which will repair and mitigate the all damages to the wetlands on the parcel as a result of your illegal wetlands activities.

Payment of this fine and completion of these requirements including within thirty (30) days of June 23, 2007, will satisfy these violation conditions.

Failure to comply with the aforesaid order will be subject to penalties as the law may provide.
